We pray the word of God. We use scriptures that applies to prayer needs to produce dynamic results.

Hebrews 4:12 - ¹² For the word of God is **quick, and powerful**, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Jer 1:12 - Then said the Lord to me, You have seen well, for I am **alert and active**, watching over My word to **perform it**.

Isaiah 55:11 - So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it **shall accomplish what I please**, and it shall **prosper in the thing** for which **I sent it**.

Rom 8:26-28 (AMP): ²⁶ So too the **[Holy] Spirit** comes to our aid *and* bears us up in our weakness; for we **do not know what prayer** to offer *nor* how to offer it worthily as we ought, but the Spirit Himself goes **to meet our supplication and pleads in our behalf** with unspeakable yearnings *and* groanings too deep for utterance. ²⁷ And He Who searches the hearts of men knows

what is in the mind of the [Holy] Spirit [what His intent is], because the Spirit intercedes *and* pleads [before God] in behalf of the saints according to *and* in harmony with God's will.²⁸ We are assured *and* know that [^aGod being a partner in their labor] all things work together *and* are [fitting into a plan] for good to *and* for those who love God and are called according to [His] design *and* purpose.

1 Corinthians 14:2 (AMP): For one who speaks in an [unknown] tongue speaks not to men but to God, for no one understands *or* catches his meaning, because in the [Holy] Spirit he utters secret truths *and* hidden things [not obvious to the understanding].

2 Chronicles 7:14 (AMP): If My people, who are called by My name, shall humble themselves, pray, seek, crave, *and* require of necessity My face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.

James 5:16 (AMP): Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed *and* restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]. The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working].

CHALLENGES

The challenge is not to use the word "don't" this week. I realized today that even when I use the word "don't", I still attract what I don't want to happen. For example, I'm having a conversation with you and I say don't stare at my pimple. That's exactly what you are going to do, stare at it first and then take your eyes away. So I still attracted what I didn't want to happen. Instead of saying I don't want to be late, you can say I'm going to arrive early or I'm going to be on time, thereby shifting the focus from "being late" to "arrive early" or "on time". We attract our predominant thoughts.

Instead of saying I don't know why I don't attract the right kind of guy, you can say I attract the right kind of guy I desire. In essence you're changing the way you think and speak to say what you want to see happen, not what you don't want to see happen. So "don't" is a swear word this week....lol
